Report from January 2023

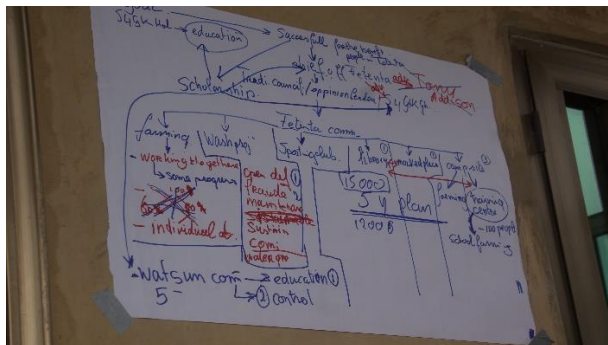
In september,2023. There was a visit from Support 4 Ghanese Kids to Ghana for us to finalise on the WASH project which was on paper 2019/2020. Through that we had a lot of consultation with the Chief of Fetentaa and his Elders, Rotary Club, Sunyani Central and Support 4 Ghanaian Kids.



Visitation to the Farm site and Discussions with the Farmers helped us to accept that they are working as a coooperate as we desired earlier, which really help them during their Farming activities.



On the part of the Agricultural project, the first season was great and farmers took a healthy smile home but the second season encountered challeges of Climate, Pescides and theft issues which was a lost to the second quarter, Farmers facing pressures although there have been some welcome downward moves in energy of Farmers in the community but the engagements and white paper sections we had together still bell in their ears “we can make it happen”so far as there is 4arces irrigated land with 24 hours accesss to water.



The white paper sections enlightened Support 4 Ghanaian Kids Team to gear and plan for projects and activities. It brought the ideas of the farmers, Kidz Run and the sporting Club executives to get a plan which can energise them as a Cooperative.

The joyful sensation from Nana Kofi Nti, Elders and some Kids at Fetentaa Palace made our community visit to sites.



The Kidz Run was realised successfully to sensitise kids on hygienic consequences and proper use of water and a tool for internationalisation with the Kids in Netherlands. Again a booster to the Sporting Club.



Kids exhibition on food preparation which was also a great moment for Ghanaian kids to demonstrate their cuisine by cooking local foods.



A toilet facility with mechanised borehole and water for the schools in Fetentaa is in progress. Regular visitation and Discussions with the WATSAN committee so far is on good note. A participatory Evaluation course with Wilde Ganzen on projects are on course and adding value to our Projects.



2024 OUTLOOK

Looking ahead at prospects over 2024, the sector of Agricultural, where school gardens will be introduced as well to schools, Sporting Club activeness, WASH Project and a realisation of Scholarship and Education.

Support 4 Ghanaian Kids has made strong operational and strategic progress plan on how to realise internationalisation exchange programs among kids through Kidz Run and Culture activities.

We anticipate this WASH project to impact on at least 60% kids in the schools, as well as the and Zongo community area use of basic hygiene and sanitation.

We plan to manage these headwinds through efficiency and productivity improvements and other measures where possible for Agriculture Project to generate funds. This gives a solid platform for continuing development and supports our ongoing investment plans on Agriculture. These include a major programme of training to farmers.

Moreover, we continue to seek sponsors opportunities that meet our vision.

We believe that Support 4 Ghanaian Kids and our sponsors is in a good position to make further progress this year.
